Future Pathways progression



Bordon Future Skills Centre (FSC) students studying our Future Pathways course recently completed their first term project before they broke up for Christmas. Using the skills they had learned during their first 14 weeks, they were able to construct an oak box, with a hinged lid using traditional dovetail joints. In 2019 the students will initially focus on learning the basic skills associated with brickwork and plumbing, before embarking on an end of year project.

On Monday 7 January, the FSC was proud to host the official opening of the Whitehill and Bordon Relief Road. The new £20m road will provide a free flowing alternative to the existing A325 and provide access to new houses and local businesses in Bordon, including the FSC.
