



Apprenticeship Employer Incentives

- ◆ Employers who hire an apprentice 16 - 18 years of age at enrolment are entitled to a £1000 Government incentive payment paid in two instalments of £500 after 90 days and 365 days.
- ◆ Employers are not required to pay the employer National Insurance contributions throughout the duration of the apprenticeship for an apprentice under the age of 25 at enrolment and earning less than £43,000 per year.

Additional COVID-19 Grants

- ◆ Between 1 April 2021 until 30 September 2021, all business who hire new apprentices of any age are entitled to an additional £3000 Government COVID-19 Grant per apprentice.
- ◆ The grants are paid in two instalments of 50% after 90 days and 50% after 365 days.
- ◆ The COVID-19 grant is in addition to the incentive payment for apprentices aged 16 - 18 years of age or those under 25 with an Education, Health and Care Plan, with £4000 the maximum amount an employer could receive until 30 September 2021.
