

Apprenticeship Employer Incentives

- Employers who hire an apprentice 16 18 years of age at enrolment, who are NEW employees and are NEW to apprenticeship standards, are entitled to a £1000 Government incentive payment.
- Incentive payments are payable in two instalments of 50% after 90 days and 50% after 365 days.
- Employers are not required to pay the employer National Insurance contributions throughout the duration of the apprenticeship for an apprentice under the age of 25 at enrolment and earning less than £43,000 per year.
